BEFORE YOU LEAVE

Deferment Timing

Submit your deferment after you receive your mission call and before the end of the semester that you were supposed to attend BYU. Any BYU scholarship will also be deferred until you return from your mission (*deferment.byu.edu*).

Guest Access

Give someone access to your BYU account while you are on your mission. Set up Guest Access at *guestaccess.byu.edu*.

Registration

Plan your classes to make it easier to register for classes when you return. Contact your college advisement center for help at *advisement.byu.edu*.

Finances and Student Accounts

Check your My Financial Center at *mfc.byu.edu* to pay outstanding balances and cancel scheduled payments. If you have a federal student loan, contact your servicer to discuss options.

DURING YOUR MISSION

If your plans change and you will be returning from your mission before/after the date you indicated on your deferment, update the form and resubmit it (deferment.byu.edu).

BEFORE YOU RETURN

Ecclesiastical Endorsement

Go to *endorse.byu.edu* to initiate an ecclesiastical endorsement. The earliest you can submit an endorsement is nine months before you return to BYU. Submit before your priority registration date.

Financial Aid and Scholarships Deadline

To be considered for federal student aid and scholarships, complete the FAFSA and BYU scholarship application by February 1 of the year you return. To learn more about eligibility for scholarships, go to *scholarships.byu.edu*.
