ADVANCED PLACEMENT CREDIT AT BRIGHAM YOUNG UNIVERSITY FOR 2013

BYU will only award elective college credit for exams that do not receive GE or specific course credit. Exams that meet this criterion will receive 3 elective credits for a score of 4 or 5.
